# **BERTOTTI MARCO**



He was born in Turin on 4 October 1966, is married to Elisa and has two children, Alberto and Federica.

He attended Economics & Commerce at the University of Turin in the mid-80s and joined the Istituto Bancario Sanpaolo di Torino, a then-leading national bank, in April 1987.

He worked for several departments of the Foreign Exchange Dealing Room, carrying out liquidity management, trading activities on Money markets, FX and short-term derivatives.

He took over the responsibility as of Head of Money Market and Short-term Derivatives at Sanpaolo IMI in January 2000. Across the turn of the century, he oversaw and coordinated the transition to the stage-III of EMU for the bank, as far as payment systems and short-term liquidity markets are concerned.

From October 2003, he enlarged his responsibility to the FX markets.

Since the merger between Banca Intesa and Sanpaolo IMI (November 2007), he moved to Milan to cover the role of Head of Euro Money Market and

Payment Systems, role that widened to the management and supervision of the money markets in all currencies from September 2013.

In December 2018 and up to now, he's been appointed Head of Treasury and Deputy Head of Group Treasury and Finance.

In his career, he represented the bank in several institutionalmoney market working groups: member of the ECB Money Market Contact Group for 10 years, member of the ACI (The Financial Market Association and Assiom Forex) technical committees.

Additionally, he joined the EMMI (European Money Market Institute) as a member of the Eonia and Euribor Task Force.
